 - 3- Health Authorities from the Export markets



What are our capabilities today:

1- We manufacture:

Tablets / Capsules / Cream / Gel / Syrup / Serums / Injectables.

- 2- We produce under license from reputable multinationals, European, US, Japanese
- 3- We cover 7% of the Lebanese Pharmaceutical Market
- 4- We have 1800 qualified employees most of them are postgraduate; Doctors, pharmacists, chemists & technicians
- 5- We still have 50% free production capacity
