Interest Subsidy



Loans extended to local private sector projects in the industrial, touristic, agricultural, IT development and handicrafts sectors benefit from a 4.5% Lebanese Government interest subsidy rate to finance a new project or the expansion of an existing one, with a value of LBP 50Mn – LBP 15Bn.



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Micro Credit



- Loans granted through micro credit institutions to *individuals* and *small enterprises* employing four people or less, in order to help them start or develop their business in industrial, service, touristic or commercial sectors, provided the following:
 - 1. The loan amount does not exceed LBP 20 million.
 - 2. Its repayment period does not exceed 5 years.
 - 3. The amount of Micro Credit approved to date is around LBP<u>90</u>bn, covering <u>4,134 beneficiaries</u>.



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Educational Loans




- Loans granted in LBP to support tuition fees in higher education institutions (academic, vocational or technical):
- They are reimbursed within a period of ten years starting one year after the graduation date.
- All interest and commissions should not exceed 3%.
- The amount of Educational Loans approved to date is around LBP<u>71</u>bn, covering <u>1,892 beneficiaries</u>.



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

■ BDL would pay a 15% grant to subsidize loans extended to SMEs to finance energy projects (except residential projects), with a maximum grant of \$750,000 per project.

■ To date, the grant is fully allocated and **USD 3.11 Mn** have been advanced to projects that are completed according to set criteria.

Banks may benefit from interest-free facilities granted for a maximum period of 7 years for their participation, at their full responsibility, in the capital of startup companies, incubators and accelerators, venture capital companies (Knowledge Economy اقتصاد المعرفة / Intellectual Capital (المهارات الفكرية الابداعية). These facilities will be invested in treasury bills, accounts, operations or securities.
