

Tracking prices for the most essential goods available on the Lebanese market





ABOUT THIS REPORT

This report is the result of a joint project between the Ministry of Economy and Trade (MoET) and the World Food Programme (WFP). The project aims to implement a market price information system and economic analysis in Lebanon, with the goal of enhancing the Ministry's capacity to monitor prices in the current context of economic volatility and insecurity.

The report is composed of three main sections:

- A high-level view of the latest price trends through the lens of the Market Food Price Index (MFPI)
- An **in-depth analysis** per food category and governorate
- An annex table displaying the latest prices nationally and per governorate

This report was based on price monitoring data of 73 food and non-food items from a representative sample of around 1,000 shops located across the eight governorates.

Data is collected weekly and stored on a price monitoring system hosted by WFP.

MARKET FOOD PRICE INDEX (MFPI)

Key highlights

The MFPI reached **127.4** in July 2024, driven since January 2023 by an index evolution in **vegetables and tubers** (158.8), **fruits** (210.3), **cereals** (117.8), and **fresh poultry** (141).

The price index has increased by **0.2 percent** between June 2024 and July 2024, with decreases in the index of **fruits** (-4.4 percent) and **vegetables and tubers** (-1.4 percent) offsetting increases in the indexes of **fresh poultry** (+5.4 percent) and **beverages** (+1.6 percent).

The highest MFPI was observed in **Beirut** (132.0) and **North Lebanon** (129.3).

KEY DRIVERS

The conflict along the Southern border negatively affected local agriculture and poultry production, causing


agriculture and poultry production, causing prices of poultry and vegetables to increase at a greater pace than that of other commodities.

Damages to poultry production in the south are pushing poultry prices upwards. A greater supply of fruits in the local market amid rising obstacles to exports caused a drop in the fruit index.

MFPI Evolution (Jan 23 - Jul 24)




The Market Food Price Index (MFPI) is a measure of the average change over time in the prices in US dollars paid by consumers for 63 essential food items. It is calculated as the weighted average of price changes for each of its components. The base month of the index is January 2023.


ANALYSIS

Overview

Higher costs of living, transportation, and distribution, as well as larger urban areas leading to higher demand, led to a more notable trend in Beirut and North Lebanon between January 2023 and July 2024, while better access to locally produced foods kept indexes lower in Nabatieh and Akkar.



Market Food Price Index by Governorate (July 2024) Base = January 2023)




Notable Trends:


- Each governorate had notable price evolutions in different components:
 - **Akkar**: Highest yearly evolution in beverages (+17 percent) and canned fish (+14 percent). Highest monthly evolution in beverages (+5 percent), canned fish (+3 percent), and cereals (+3 percent).
 - **Baalbek El Hermel**: Highest monthly increase in the price index of pulses (+2.3 percent). Slight monthly decrease in the index of fresh poultry (-1 percent) compared to a 5 percent monthly increase nationally.
 - **Beirut**: Highest yearly increase in the price indexes of fats and oils (+13 percent) and vegetables and tubers (+58 percent).
 - **Bekaa**: Highest yearly increase in the price index of dairy (+18 percent) and pulses (+20.3 percent). Biggest monthly drop in the price index of sugar (-3 percent).
 - **Mount Lebanon**: Second highest yearly increase in the price indexes of fresh poultry (+63 percent) and pulses (+20.1 percent).
 - Nabatieh: Highest monthly increase in the price indexes of condiments (+4 percent), fruits (+42 percent) and vegetables and tubers (+5 percent). Biggest yearly drop in the price index of eggs (-20 percent) and sugar (-8 percent).
 - **North**: Highest yearly increase in the price index of cereals (+20 percent), fruits (+37 percent), condiments (+19.2 percent), and sugar (+4 percent).
 - **South**: Highest monthly (+44 percent) and yearly (+86 percent) increase in the price index of fresh poultry. Notable 14 percent monthly drop in the price index of fruits.

Monthly and yearly price evolution by governorate and component


MFPI Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




MFPI Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Component - National




Beverages - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Canned Fish - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Cereals - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Condiments - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Dairy - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Eggs - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Fats & Oils - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Fresh Poultry - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Fruits - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Pulses - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate
