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Summary

This report provides a summary of all Non-Tariff Measures NTMs on trade imposed by various Lebanese government state bodies on import and export of goods. Measures include prohibitions, licenses and visas (TBT and SPS certificates). Please see Table 1 below.

Lebanon is continuously reviewing and assessing the conformity of all the imposed NTMs, with WTO agreements. Lebanon is also evaluating its licensing regime and has prepared a licensing legislation that will be in conformity with the WTO Agreement on licensing.

In the current regime: Licenses should be obtained prior to the import/export of goods .The license might be permanent or limited by a time period. A license is usually obtained within a week and can be easily renewed. In most cases, a license may be used to conduct multiple import transactions within the terms of the license. Any legal or natural person may apply for a license except (i) where a qualification requirement is needed (insecticides and Pesticides: agriculture engineer; Human Medicines: pharmacist; Veterinary Medicines: veterinarian or pharmacist) and in such case the applicant for a license should be in contract with a qualified person. Not all ministries charge fees for issuing licenses.

The following ministries: the Ministry of Economy and Trade, the Ministry of Industry, the Ministry of Energy and Water, charge the following fees according to 1999 Budget Law:

- LBP 25, 000 fee per license (3 copies are required; total of LBP 75,000)
- A fee of 0.1 percent per license of value of invoice (3 copies are required)
- LBP 10,000 stamp for copy of the issuing state body; LBP 1,000 stamp for customs copy; LBP 1,000 stamp for copy of importer

Fees are collected at the Ministry of Finance and used for fiscal purpose.

Lebanon has recently abolished license fees in Budget Law 2008.

Requirements for the licenses vary from one ministry to another and from one good to another. Procedures for obtaining import licenses apply equally to Lebanese companies with or without foreign participation, foreign companies (registered in Lebanon as branch or representative office), and natural persons (both Lebanese and foreign).

Visa is the official stamping on the custom declaration by the concerned ministry: the Ministry of Defense, the Ministry of Economy and Trade, the Ministry of Environment, the Ministry of Energy and Water, the Ministry of Interior, the Ministry of Post and Telecommunications, and the Ministry of Public Health.

The Visa indicates that the good is in compliance with certain specific requirements, including technical regulations, packaging and labelling requirement and to ensure the prevention of deceives practices, and may clear customs. The Visa is also imposed for other different purposes by different ministries: censorship, to avoid fraud, conformity with Lebanese technical regulations, health measures, sanitary and phyto-sanitary reasons, security and environmental regulations. For certain cases, visas may be issued based on importers' documents indicating compliance of the imported goods with specific requirements. In case the representative of concerned ministry or Customs suspects non-compliance of imported good with applicable requirements, testing or inspection is conducted. The Visa is then issued on the basis of test or inspection results. A visa is issued for each shipment. The Visa is issued in the same day. No fees are charged.

Table 1 summarizes the number of groups of goods subject to various trade measures at various ministries. Sections A through J of this report provides detailed description of the type of measures imposed at each of the following ministry. Section of K of this report provides a description of all measures by category.

In addition, the following measures are required:

- Veterinary or Health Certificate by the Ministry of Agriculture on all Goods of animal origin
- Phytosanitary Certificate by the Ministry of Agriculture on all goods of plant origin
- Local Laboratory Analysis Certificate may be required by all ministries issuing visas (SPS certificates)
- Laboratory Analysis Certificate may be required for the issuance of certain import licenses, primarily for food products.

In addition to the above mentioned measures the following export prohibitions date back to the Ottoman Empire:

A. Trade Measures Imposed and Administered by the Ministry of Agriculture

The following two departments at the Ministry of Agriculture administer trade measures:

- The Animal Resources Directorate
- The Plant Resources Directorate

The Animal Resources Directorate:

- prohibits the import of a list of products of animal origin for animal health reasons. (*see table MOA 1*)
- prohibits the import of a list of veterinary drugs, and vaccines for diseases not proven to exist in Lebanon. (*see List MOA 1*) These prohibitions are based on International recommendations and guidelines especially those of the Codex and the OIE.
- imposes License on the import and the export on a limited number of animal products for health reasons. (*see tables MOA 2 and MOA 3 respectively*). The validity of the license is determined according to the health situation in the country of origin and according to the nature of the product..
- requires Certificate of origin for the import of all products of animal origin.
- requires Health or Veterinary Certificate for the import of all products of animal origin.

Recently eliminated measures:

- The prohibition on a list of animal products was eliminated.
- The Quotas on the export of animal feed was eliminated.

The Plant Resources Directorate:

- prohibits the import of a list of Pesticides, following the international guidelines (FAO, WHO and the EU) (*see List MOA 2*) for health measure, and the import of Cedars seeds and seedlings for the conservation of the Lebanese Cedars species. (*see table MOA 4*)
- prohibits the export of a list of products of plant origin. (*see table MOA 5*). This prohibition is mainly for the conservation of the forest resources
- imposes a License on the import and the export of a list of Plant products for health reasons. (*see table MOA 6,7 respectively*).
- requires certificate of origin needed for the import of all plants and plant products
- requires Phyto-Sanitary Certificate for the import of all plants and plant products.
- requires Certificate of Specialization for the import of certain seeds and seedlings.

Recently eliminated measures:

- The quota on the import of potato seeds was eliminated.

B. Trade Measures Imposed and Administered by the Ministry of Economy and Trade

The following three departments at the MET administer trade measures:

- Department of Foreign Trade
- Department of Consumer Protection

The Department of Foreign Trade:

- prohibits the import of only one good: the Carter Ritof, which is a Secret ink. HS 3824.90 for security reasons. (Ministry of Economy Decision No. 8293, dated, 23 November 1951)
- imposes License on the import and the export of arms, ammunitions, explosive materials, and all the items for military purposes, for security reasons. (*see table MET 1*). The License is issued upon the Advance Approval of the Ministry of Interior or the Ministry of Defense, and sometimes upon the Advance Approval of the Council of Ministers, according to the type of the goods. It is valid for 6 months for import and 3 months for export. No licenses are required from the Ministry of Economy and Trade if the invoice value is below LBP 1 Million according to the Ministry of Economy and Trade Decision No. 127/1/AT dated August 23, 1997.

The Department of Consumer Protection imposes a Visa (TBT or SPS Certificate) on the import of mainly foodstuffs for human consumption and on alcoholic drinks. (*see table MET 2*). In general, such goods may not clear customs without a visa. Goods, however, may clear customs without visa under the condition that they may not be put for circulation until test results are received.

The MET imposes Visa is to protect consumers by ensuring conformity with Lebanese technical regulations and adopted international standards (Codex Alimentarius) and to ensure the prevention of deceptive practices.

The licenses imposed by the General Directorate for Grains and Sugar Beet (CSBO on the import of wheat, and on all their derivatives (*see table MET 3*) have been cancelled by Minister of Economy and Trade Decision 38 dated Sept. 27, 2007.

C. Trade Measures Imposed and Administered by the Ministry of Environment:

The measures of the MOE, with regard to the import of waste, are within the context of the Basel Convention 1989; Lebanon ratified this treaty in 1994. The Ministry of Environment (MOE):

- prohibits the import of a list of goods (*see table MOE 1,2*) in order to protect the Lebanese environment against dangerous and poisonous waste.
- imposes a Visa on the import of a list of waste (*see table MOE 3*) to protect also the Lebanese environment.
- doesn't impose any licensing on imports or exports.

D. Trade Measures Imposed and Administered by the Ministry of Energy and Water:

The General Directorate of Oil is the department that administers trade measures at the Ministry of Energy and Water (MEW). The General Directorate of Oil:

- prohibits the import of leaded Motor spirit gasoline 92,95 and 98 octane (HS 27101120,27101130) and unleaded motor spirit gasoline 90 octane (HS 27101115) to protect the environment. This prohibition is applied upon the Council of Ministers Decree No 8442 dated 13/8/2002.
- imposes license and visa on the import of a list of goods (*See table MEW 1*), to ensure conformity with Lebanese technical regulations and that goods are not fraudulent. Import licenses are valid for 3 months. Currently, no limit on quantity is imposed.
- imposes license on the export of a list of goods. (*See table MEW 2*) for the purpose of securing local consumption needs. Export licenses are valid for 3 months. No limit on quantity is imposed.
- prohibits the transit of oil and oil derivatives.

The General Directorate of Industry at the Ministry of Industry MOI:

- doesn't apply any kind of Export Prohibitions.
- The prohibition for the import of clinker/black cement (HS 252329-252330-252390-252310) for 5 years starting 28/10/99 to protect and support the local industry of cement has ended.
- imposes license on the import of a list of goods to protect the local production except for one product (asbestos) for the purpose of protecting the environment and the public health.(see table MOI 1)
- imposes license on the export of a list of goods to provide the needed raw materials for the local industry.(see table MOI 2). This license is limited by quantity and is valid for a period of 6 months, during which the importer/exporter may import and export many shipments without exceeding the authorized quantity. The quantity mentioned in the import license is given according to the importer's demand.
- ratifies the Performa invoice and the Certificate of origin before exporting goods, when this ratification is required by multilateral or bilateral agreements between Lebanon and the country to which goods are exported.

G. Trade Measures Imposed and Administered by the Ministry of Public Health

The following three departments at the Ministry of Public Health (MPH) administer trade measures:

- Department of Sanitary Engineering
- Department of Narcotics
- Department of Importation and Exportation of Medicines

The Department of Sanitary Engineering:

- prohibits the import of a list of goods for sanitary reasons. (*see table MPH 1*)
- imposes license on the import of a list of goods for health reasons. (*see table MPH2*) .The license is limited by a time limit, but it is not limited by quantity. The validity or the time limit of the license differs according to the nature of the good. For certain goods such as water and juices, the license are permanent. But, this license can be revoked at any time if the concerned person violates license terms.
- imposes a Visa on import and export for health reasons. (*see table MPH ,3,4*)
- does not impose any restrictions on transit.

The Section of Importation and Exportation of Medicines:

- Before the Import of any kind of human medicines, the concerned medicine should be registered at the Section of Importation and Exportation of Medicines at the Ministry of Public Health. (Law 367 article 54, Law on Practicing the Profession of Pharmacy, dated 8/19/94)..
- The Section of Importation and Exportation of Medicines imposes a Visa on the import and the export of a list of goods for health reasons (*see table MPH 5*)

The Department of Narcotics:

- prohibits the import, export and transit of a list of hazardous substances to human health and that are of no medical use.(*see MPH list 1*)

- imposes license and a visa on the import and the export of a list of hazardous substances but proven to be of medical use (*see MPH list 2*). The License is only provided after proving that these dangerous substances are imported for medical purposes only.

Note:

Decree No. 2432 dated March 2, 2000 is now governing the import and export of narcotics.

All previous laws or Decisions on drugs and narcotics have been cancelled.
